

Kars on the Rideau School Council Events Rules for Fundraiser "Walks"

(Cake Walk and Jar Walk)

The Kars on the Rideau School Council Fundraiser Walk events are intended to be student-focused, enjoyable fundraisers in which all funds generated are directed back into initiatives that will benefit the students of Kars on the Rideau Public School. Students purchase tickets that may be placed in containers in front of an item to be won (e.g. cakes or jars, etc.). A draw is then made for each item, and the winning student brings their prize home.

The following represents the rules for all KotR School Council Fundraiser Walk events:

- 1. Students shall be permitted to place tickets in the draw for any item that they would like. No restrictions will be placed on the number or distribution of tickets placed by the child.
- 2. The draw for each item will be a random selection from all tickets submitted for that particular item.
- 3. Students may win a maximum of one item per each event.
- 4. In the case where a winner's name is drawn more than once, the winner will win the <u>first</u> item s/he drew. His/her ticket will be discarded if chosen for subsequent prizes. A new and unique winner will be re-drawn by the event organizers for each item in the Walk.
- 5. There are no restrictions on the number of winners in a class or in a family.

The easiest and most efficient way of processing winners is when ALL winning names have been determined BEFORE the students are called to the gym to claim their prize.
